Letter From Leadership

I've long thought of spring as the unofficial start to the year in Minnesota as we see winter end and the best of Minnesota's weather before us. I also think such beginnings and endings are the most exciting times in our business when it comes to the work we do. The team's energy always seems a little brighter when we're either kicking off a job or wrapping up a successful project. Fortunately, as I write this our Commercial Market group is in the middle of both a significant start and a milestone ending.

The new project recently underway is the Hines Development/Kraus-Anderson North Loop Green Tower in downtown Minneapolis. This 1 million SF, multi-use development consists of a 14-story office building, 34-story residential tower, 4-story parking structure, and space for retail & restaurants with a green outdoor area for community events. A great project that will add yet another tower to the Minneapolis skyline.

On the flip side, we are also pleased to be putting the finishing touches on the United Properties/McGough Gateway Tower project we began in 2018. Gateway Tower has received a lot of press lately for being both the newest office tower in downtown Minneapolis and bringing the first 5-star hotel to the Twin Cities in the form of the Four Seasons Hotel. At 37-stories, the tower is one of the ten tallest buildings in downtown Minneapolis. The 1.2 million SF building hosts RBC Wealth Management, United Properties and other companies, and there are 34 private residences sitting at the top of the tower. This great project will be completely wrapped up in May.

One thing both projects have in common – and that is a special point of pride for Gephart – is our early participation in the Preconstruction phase of these jobs. This allowed our team to make significant contributions to these projects through suggesting the best locations for things like major equipment, stacked electrical and telecom rooms, security rooms, etc. Also, always welcomed by the Owners, we worked with the GC's involved to save over \$2 million between the two projects. By doing this, North Memorial Health's people didn't miss a beat in continuing their work. Additionally, our team moved power poles, added a new UPS panel, and installed new LED lighting. We were able to accomplish all this during the peak of a pandemic inside a fully functioning lab – quite a success!
